ELEMENTARY:

1. **Alpine:** No Bully Program, Regular meetings Safety/Security Team - researching Conflict Mediation programs to implement next year, IB remarry years PROFILE CARDS, ATTITUDES, and Students Taking Action, grade 5 Lunch Bunch incentive program, monthly all school meetings, child studies, behavior plans, risk assessment plans and contracts, Website access to the SVVSD safety site, school handbooks including safety procedures, IEP process, school improvement team monthly reports including safety/security and discipline, recess before lunch program, once a year student, staff, parent survey
2. **Burlington:** Positive Behavior Support program, No Bully program, Kids' Hope Mentoring, Classroom Buddies, Classroom Community Meetings, Student Council develops playground rules, service oriented student council, teacher-led boys and girls groups during lunch, grade 5 after school homework club, self-referral box for counseling issues, girl's book club, classrooms count complements, review of Kagan curriculum for possible adaptation
3. **Central:** Positive Behavior Support program, No Bully Program, Peace Place, Walk and Roll to School, reverse lunch schedule—recess first, PE teachers emphasize physical fitness with jump roping, juggling, bi-weekly positive recognition with Lunchtime Laureates, Student of the Month
4. **Columbine:** "It's My Body" Program, grant application pending for W.H.O. (We Help Ourselves)
5. **Eagle Crest:** No Bully Program, Peace Place, Mediation, Character Education, Personal Safety, child studies, Principal's High Five, Fire Safety House, firemen, respect/self confidence assembly, eating healthy program through CSU, Red Ribbon week assembly, random act of kindness chain through student council
6. **Erie El:** Positive Behavior Support, No Bully Program, Peace Pals, Student Safety meetings, Monthly Town Hall meetings, child studies, CARE, life issues groups
7. **Fall River:** Positive Behavior Support, Classroom Guidance on Conflict Mediation
8. **Frederick:** No Bully Program, Peace Place, Classroom Guidance on Conflict Resolution and Stranger Danger, CARE Program
9. **Hygiene:** Peace Pals, reverse lunch schedule—recess first, PE teachers emphasize healthy heart lifestyles, high teacher attendance at student extracurricular activities such as soccer, football
10. **Indian Peaks:** Peace Place, No Bully Program, Character Student of the Month, Classroom Community Meetings, Vertical Teams, Intramural grade 4 & 5 soccer participation tied into academics, behavior and attendance, Kids' Hope mentors, Safe Touch, Student Council, Fire Safety House, small group intervention, MESA, after school International Studies club

11. **Legacy:** “LEGACY Traits”—Listen Actively, Express Yourself Respectfully, Go for your Goals, Accept responsibility, Care for and cooperate with others, You’re the Leader, No Bullying Program, Emergency Response Team, Safety Committee that plans with town emergency response personnel
12. **Loma Linda:** Bullying awareness and prevention, CHAMPS mentoring, Safety, Gang Prevention/Awareness—students and parents, child studies, Triple L Awards, Staff Professional Development on safety, well-being and achievement related to poverty, building-wide expectations for respect and tolerance, Community School After School Program, CAP-Child Assault Prevention
13. **Longmont Estates:** Peace Place, Don’t Laugh At Me program, Classroom Community meetings, Fire Prevention Week, child studies, jog-a-thon, Jump Rope for Heart, parent breakfasts, Safe Routes Program
14. **Lyons:** Peace Pals, Child Studies, goal setting assembly, jog-a-thon, SRO classroom visits
15. **Mead:** Positive Behavior Support, Circle of Friends, child studies, Study Buddies, No Bullying Program, Student Council
16. **Mountain View:** No Bully Program, Kids’ Hope mentoring, Peace Place, child studies, After School Program
17. **Niwot:** No Bully Program, Peace Place, child studies, character pledge every AM, character trait once a month, character assembly, study buddies, positive behavior wall, sister school relationship with Loma Linda, safety NET (no easy target) kids seminar, Working to Become a Green Star School
18. **Northridge:** No Bully Program, Peace Place, Safe Touch, Classroom Community Visits, Gang Prevention, Growing Up—grade 5, After School Program, School-Wide discipline plan, Vertical teams
19. **Prairie Ridge:** No Bully Program, Classroom Community visits pro-social skills, I message culture to reduce conflict, child studies, Circle of Friends, pro social skills
20. **Rocky Mountain:** Peer Mediation, Growing Up- grade 5
21. **Sanborn:** Positive Behavior Support, No Bully Program, Peace Place, Safe Touch, Classroom Community visits, Gang Prevention, Growing up—grade 5, 50 mile club child studies, teacher/principal once/month review of academic/social/emotional developments on each child, goal of getting every student involved in community schools programs
22. **Spangler:** Kids Hope mentoring, Peace Place, Classroom Community visits, Gang Prevention, Developmental Assets, Don’t Laugh At Me, Girl Scouts Personal Empowerment, Cub Scouts, MESA, mentor reading program, child studies, parent link with city of Longmont for hosting community building program called “Tamales and Talk,” 50 mile club, fire prevention week
