- Classrooms will be updated to enhance learning communities with St. Vrain's 2008 Educational Specifications.

- Interior doors will be refinished or replaced and ADA compliant hardware will be installed.
- Remove the old sidewalks and replace deteriorated elements with new concrete.
- Refinish existing flooring to enhance education environments as needed.
- Replace the water closets and flush valves, lavatories and faucets.
- Installation of a fire sprinkler system as required.
- Upgrade electrical services and the fire alarm systems.
- Repair or replace deteriorated roofing systems as required.
