

Accountability Process Timeline

By September 1

School-level accountability committee adopts building goals and plan for the coming year to improve educational achievement.

Objectives and plans reviewed by District Accountability Committee and submitted to Board of Education.

By October 1

Report by Board to State Board of Education after consultation with District Accountability Committee on each school's goals and plans. All data required to be reported by school buildings to the Board also to be reported to the public.

Board of Education submits District goals and objectives and District plan to improve educational achievement and maximize graduation rates to State Board.

By December 1

Written report provided to public and State Board on accreditation indicators.

After January 15

Within a reasonable time after receipt of the State Accountability Report, distribution to parents and public.
