

Accountability/Commitment to Accomplishment

The Board accepts ultimate responsibility for the academic accomplishments of District students. Consistent with this responsibility and as required by law, the Board shall adopt and maintain an accountability process to measure the adequacy and efficiency of the education program.

The Board shall appoint or create a process for the selection of a District Accountability/Accreditation Committee which shall make recommendations to the Board relative to the process of accountability. The areas of study by the committee shall be determined cooperatively at least annually by the committee and the Board.

A schedule of meetings shall be posted and all District accountability/accreditation meetings will be open to the public.
