

## **Administration Goals/Priority Objectives**

The purpose of school administration is to help create and foster an environment in which students can learn most effectively. Administrative duties and functions shall be established to contribute to that end.

The Board shall rely on the Superintendent to provide the professional administrative leadership.

The design of the administrative organization shall be such that all departments of the District and all schools are part of a single system subject to the policies set forth by the Board and implemented through the Superintendent. The principals of all schools and the administrators of all divisions and departments are expected to administer their units in accordance with Board policy and administrative regulations.
