

Free and Reduced-Price Food Services

In cooperation with the state and federal government, the school district shall participate actively in the school meals programs. The district believes in the nutritional and educational value of school meals and intends to serve such meals when practical from the standpoint of facilities and available trained personnel.

The administration shall establish regulations which conform with state and federal (or other) requirements regarding participation in programs for free and reduced price meals and supplementary food. Such regulations shall be presented to the Board from time to time for its approval.
