

Professional Staff Positions

All instructional, administrative and supervisory positions in the District shall be established initially by the Board. All changes in the titles and/or responsibilities of administrative and supervisory positions shall be approved by the Board.

In each case, the Board shall approve the broad purpose and function of the position in harmony with state laws and regulations and approve a statement of job requirements as recommended by the Superintendent.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent or designee the task of writing job descriptions which must include any essential functions required for specific positions.
