

Support Staff Emergency Closure

When there is an approved emergency closure of administrative units in the District, classified employees shall be allowed regular pay entitlement under the following conditions:

1. An emergency closure is defined as the closure of work sites by order of the Superintendent or designee.
2. Supervising administrators may require a person to report to work during an emergency closure.
3. Employees who are required to work during an emergency closure of their regular work station shall be allowed double pay for their regular work day/hours.
4. Emergency closure pay provisions will apply to all regular classified employees.
5. Emergency closure with pay shall be allowed any employee for up to two (2) days in one year (July 1 through June 30). Additional days may be authorized by the Superintendent.
