

Travel Study

1. All arrangements for out-of-state or out-of-country travel study trips sponsored by the District must be made in compliance with the regulations governing other out-of-state student travel.
2. Complete information as to academic credit to be earned as a part of a proposed travel study trip must be included in the application to the appropriate administrative personnel and the Board of Education.
3. Information regarding the awarding of academic credit for a travel study trip must be made known to students prior to enrollment in the course or activity. If a student does not wish to participate in a travel study trip which is a requirement for course credit, the student will be given the opportunity to earn academic credit by participation in a special project or other approved activity as arranged by the teacher in charge.
