

## School Attendance Areas

Attendance areas for each elementary school, middle school, middle/high and high school of the District shall be created to provide for neighborhood schools as much as possible, where a majority of the students are within a reasonable proximity to their assigned schools. Attendance areas for these schools shall be developed in accordance with the guidelines established in Board policy JCAA (School Districting/Redistricting) and regulation JCAA-R (School Boundary Change Guidelines).

A student's designated attendance area shall be based on the student's legal residence as determined by Colorado State Statutes.

Magnet or charter schools of the District may not have a determined attendance area. Acceptance of enrollment will be based on the individual school's application process.
