

School-Community Relations Goals (Purpose and Objectives)

Purpose

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of being accountable to and involved in each community within the District. To this end, schools in both rural and urban areas of the District shall serve as centers for community-oriented activities and community members will be encouraged to work collaboratively with District personnel to establish school-community programs and provide input on local and district-wide decisions.

Objectives

1. Improve school-community working relationships
2. Meet the social, physical and educational needs of district patrons
3. Encourage community use of school facilities and resources
4. Encourage parental and general patron involvement in the schools and inclusion on committees at both the District and building levels
5. Establish schools as centers of community activities
6. Bring patrons closer to the school and enhance attitudes toward the schools
7. Coordinate activities with other agencies in the district
8. Improve education for in-school youth by:
 - a. Encouraging a closer working relationship between teachers, parents, students, administrators and community members
 - b. Better use of human and physical resources, e.g., library, people, counseling services

Programs

School-community cooperative programs may be determined by community members in cooperation with the District's designated school-community directors and the appropriate building principal.

School support

The District shall provide school facilities and leadership for developing school-community cooperative programs.
