

Public Conduct on School Property

Police authorities may be requested to assist in controlling disturbances which the principal or designee have found to be unmanageable or which have the potential of causing harm to students, other person or property.

Such potential of possible harm includes members of the general public who exhibit undesirable or illegal conduct or any other breach of peace or violation of law on school premises or at a school event on school property and who have been requested to leave by an administrator but have refused or failed to do so.

A complaint report or incident report should be recorded and filed with both the police authorities and the school.
